DIRECTIONS:

1. Review the elective descriptions for your class year on the website at jbha.info/academic/electives.htm.
2. Select your elective classes for each trimester.
3. Review your selections with your advisor.
4. Have your parents sign the form. If they have any questions, they should contact your advisor and he/she will direct them to other staff members as needed. The quickest response will be through email.
5. Sign up on the Portal account for your elective courses. Enrollment in many of the courses will be limited and available on a first come basis.

You will be notified by email shortly, letting you know when you can login to the parent portal to request the courses you have chosen on the other side. This notification will include instructions and directions for logging in and filling out the portal course request form.

6. Return the form to your Advisor on or before, *Tuesday, May 18, 2010*. If the form is not returned, you may not get your first choice from your on-line selection for electives.
