**DIRECTIONS:**

1. Review the elective descriptions for your class year online at web site [jbha.info/academic/electives.htm](http://jbha.info/academic/electives.htm).
2. Select your elective classes for trimester 1 and 2. If you wish to enroll in AP Government or AP Literature, you must meet the prerequisites as outlined in the course guide and have the Department Chair, Mrs. Levin (Humanities) sign off on your selection.
3. Select a Math and/or Science course. You must take at least one and are strongly encouraged to take both a Math and a Science class. All Math and Science courses need the signatures of the Department Chairs, Mrs. August (Science) and Mrs. Shrager (Math). You do NOT sign up on-line for Math and Science courses.
4. Review your choices for electives and math/science courses with Mrs. Jacobs (College Counselor)
5. Review your selections with your advisor.
6. You and your parents need to sign the form. If there are any questions, contact Mrs. Jacobs and she will direct them to other staff members as needed. The quickest response will be through email.
7. Sign up on-line at the PORTAL account for your elective courses. Enrollment in many of the courses will be limited and available on a first come basis.  
*You will be notified by email shortly, letting you know when you can login to the parent portal to request the courses you have chosen on the other side. This notification will include instructions and directions for logging in and filling out the portal course request form.*
8. Return the form to your advisor on or before, *Tuesday, May 18, 2010*. If the form is not returned, you may not get your first choice from your on-line selection for electives.

**COURSE and ELECTIVE REQUIREMENTS:**

- Math and Science courses are for BOTH trimesters. It is strongly recommended to take both Math and Science; but seniors can take only Math or only Science.
- All AP Math and AP Science courses meet 7x/cycle. NON-AP Math and NON-AP Science courses meet 6x/cycle + 1 Free.
